Premium thread representation

Independent, impartial representatives who prepare and supervise the running and pulling of tubular goods, onshore and offshore. They bring in-depth field knowledge across connection types, materials and environments, and every review is objective.

Thread inspection and repair

Threads, casing and connections are thoroughly cleaned, visually inspected and evaluated for damage, including pitted, cut or mashed seals, galled threads, corrosion and coating integrity. Every defect we find is marked directly on the joint and noted on the inspection report.

Clean, drift and tally

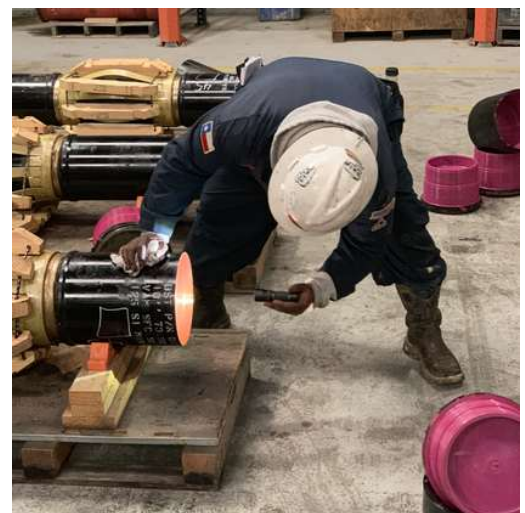
Every joint and accessory is cleaned, drifted and measured from the end of the box to the end of the pin, in feet and inches to the thousandth. Each length is recorded on our tally sheet and entered into our tally program, which takes off the manufacturer's make-up loss for the connection. You get the actual length each joint adds to the string, and a running total that matches it as installed.

Handling tool rentals

A deep inventory of handling tools for your premium connection needs. If it isn't on our shelf, we know where to get it.

Roustabout services

Field crews for general oilfield labor and location support, trained through the same internal program and held to the same safety standards as our thread representatives.
